Antonym Tips:

1. Antonyms have **opposite meanings**.
2. **careless** = not careful — opposite of careful
3. **harmful** = causes damage — opposite of helpful
4. **afraid** = feeling fear — opposite of brave
5. **famous** = well known — opposite of unknown
6. **gentle** = mild and kind — opposite of rough
7. **honest** = truthful — opposite of unfair

Remember: using antonyms makes your writing more precise!
