What a week of time travel! You learned that **history** is the study of the past. Time has three parts: the past (what already happened), the present (what is happening now), and the future (what will happen later).

You learned that **timelines** put events in order, from oldest to newest. You discovered that **artifacts** — objects like old coins, pots, and toys — are clues that historians and archaeologists use to solve mysteries about the past.
