

Monday: Adding Money Amounts**1 Warm-up coin facts**

1. 50¢, 30¢, 20¢, 35¢

2 Adding Prices (guided)

1. Read together

3 Add the Prices

1. 55¢, 55¢, 60¢, 65¢

4 Number Talk

1. B is bigger – same first addend, $35 > 25$
2. Yes, about \$1 – 49 is almost 50 and 51 is just over 50

5 Word Problem

1. $35 + 25 = 60¢$

1. 25¢, 50¢, 10¢, 75¢

2 Estimate First

1. Est 60, actual 59 / Est 80, actual 79 / Est 60, actual 62 / Est 80, actual 80

3 Column Adding

1. 59, 79, 62, 80

4 Shopping

1. 75¢, 80¢

5 Word Problem

1. $45+25=70¢$ – yes, 80¢ is enough (10¢ left)

1. 3, 8, 5, 9

2 Count Up (guided)

1. Model counting up on a number line

3 Make Change

1. 10¢, 10¢, 20¢, 45¢

4 Two Ways

1. 45→60: change 15¢ both ways
2. 25→50: change 25¢ both ways

5 Create Own

1. Accept any price <50¢ with correct change from 50¢

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Thursday: Store Transactions

1 Warm-up change from 25¢

1. 5¢, 10¢, 15¢, 20¢

2 Word Problems

1. Spends 75¢, change 25¢ from \$1
2. $75¢ \geq 55¢$ yes; change 20¢
3. Snacks 60¢, paid 75¢ – yes, enough (15¢ left)

3 Two-Step

1. Step 1: $90-25=65¢$; Step 2: $65-30=35¢$ left

4 Number Talk

1. Kim – she paid more for the same price
2. Yes – 45 is less than 50, and $50+50=100$, so $45+45 < \$1$

5 Create Own

1. Accept student-created transaction problems

1. \$1.00, \$1.00, 80¢, 60¢

2 Estimate First

1. Est 70, actual 71 / Est 70, actual 71 / Est 80, actual 73 / Est 60, actual 65

3 Add & Change Review

1. 80¢; 15¢; 75¢; 55¢

4 Word Problems

1. $75-55=20¢$ change
2. Yes – 2 pencils = 40¢, 10¢ left

1. Accept student self-assessment and reflection
