2 What Is Change? Count Up!

Change is the money you get back when you pay more than the price. **Strategy:** **count UP** from the price to what you paid.

Example: A toy costs 35¢. You pay with 2 quarters (50¢).

Count up: 35¢ → 40¢ (that's 5¢) → 50¢ (that's 10¢ more). Change = 5 + 10 = **15¢**.
