

Monday: $\times 0$, $\times 1$, $\times 2$

1 Warm-up Doubles

1. 6, 10, 8, 14

2 Easy Rules

1. 0, 4, 6, 0, 7, 12

3 2s Table blanks

1. $2 \times 3 = 6$, $2 \times 5 = 10$, $2 \times 7 = 14$, $2 \times 8 = 16$, $2 \times 10 = 20$

4 Number Talk

1. Maya is wrong – anything $\times 0 = 0$
2. $8 \times 1 = 8$ is bigger than $8 \times 0 = 0$

5 Riddle

1. The number is 7

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Tuesday: 5s and 10s

1 Warm-up

1. 5s blanks: 20, 35, 45 | 10s blanks: 30, 60, 90

2 5s Table blanks

1. $5 \times 2 = 10$, $5 \times 4 = 20$, $5 \times 6 = 30$, $5 \times 8 = 40$, $5 \times 9 = 45$

3 Estimate First

1. $3 \times 5 = 15$ less; $7 \times 5 = 35$ more; $9 \times 5 = 45$ more; $4 \times 5 = 20$ less

4 Pattern Detective

1. 5s end in 0 or 5; NO – 32 doesn't end in 0 or 5; 10s end in 0

5 Two Ways

1. 15, 20, 25, 30; $5 + 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = 30$; answer 30

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Wednesday: 3s and 4s

1 Warm-up

1. 3s blanks: 15, 21, 30 | 4s blanks: 16, 24, 36

2 3s Table blanks

1. $3 \times 4 = 12$, $3 \times 6 = 18$, $3 \times 7 = 21$, $3 \times 9 = 27$

3 Double-Doubles

1. $4 \times 5: 10 \rightarrow 20$; $4 \times 6: 12 \rightarrow 24$; $4 \times 4: 8 \rightarrow 16$; $4 \times 7: 14 \rightarrow 28$

4 Word Problems

1. $6 \times 3 = 18$ wheels; $5 \times 4 = 20$ paintbrushes

5 Chart

1. Full 0-5 chart; patterns: rows repeat skip counts, symmetric across diagonal

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Thursday: Mixed Facts & Word Problems

1 Warm-up

1. 8, 25, 9, 8, 9, 0

2 Word Problems

1. $4 \times 5 = 20$ pieces; $3 \times 5 = 15$ books; $3 \times 5 = 15$ arms

3 Two-Step

1. Step 1: $4 \times 5 = 20$. Step 2: $20 + 7 = 27$ marbles

4 Number Talk

1. 5×5 is one more 5: $20 + 5 = 25$
2. Yes – commutative; 3 rows of 4 = 4 rows of 3

5 Create Own

1. $3 \times 5 = 15$, $4 \times 4 = 16$, or $2 \times 6 = 12$

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Friday: Review & Self-Check

1 Warm-up

1. 15, 14, 16, 30, 0, 5

2 Estimate First

1. $3 \times 8 = 24$ more; $5 \times 3 = 15$ less; $4 \times 6 = 24$ more; $2 \times 9 = 18$ less

3 Skip Counting

1. 2s: 10, 16, 20 | 3s: 12, 21, 27 | 4s: 12, 24, 40 | 5s: 25, 35, 50

4 Word Problems

1. $5 \times 6 = 30$ legs; $4 \times 4 = 16$ pencils

5 Self-Check

1. Accept student self-assessment and reflection
