Monday: Math Memory Lane**1 Warm-up**

1. 16, 8, 18, 8

2 Memory Lane

1. 15; 25; 60¢; 12 – celebrate each with a drawn star

3 Number Talk

1. $29+36=65$; e.g. friendly number $30+36-1$, or $29+1=30$ then $+35$

4 Riddles

1. 32 or 34 (both even, accept either); square; quarter; 9

5 Create Riddle

1. Any riddle with a checkable answer

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Tuesday: Estimation Station & Puzzles**1 Warm-up**

1. 13, 5, 12, 8

2 Estimation Station

1. Any items; praise estimates within 10

3 Missing Numbers

1. 15; 40; 25; any pair summing to 20 (e.g. $8+12$)

4 Shape Detective

1. triangle; circle

5 Story Problem

1. $48-19+25 = 54$ coins

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Wednesday: Scavenger Hunt**1 Warm-up**

1. 50, 50, 50, 40

2 Scavenger Hunt

1. Answers vary – check reasoning, not exactness

3 Number Talk

1. 7 pairs → count by 2s or double 7 = 14 shoes

4 Bonus

1. Estimates vary; counting by 5s – any valid count

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Thursday: Design Your Own Math

1 Warm-up

1. 17, 7, 13, 7

2 Be the Teacher

1. Solve their problems (occasionally get one 'wrong' so they can catch you!)

3 Estimate First

1. Silly estimates – discuss what makes an estimate reasonable

4 Two Ways

1. $35+47=82$; column method; friendly: $35+50-3$; break apart: $30+40=70$, $5+7=12$

5 Story Problem

1. $36+28=64$; $75-64 = 11$ more points

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Friday: Celebration & Certificate

1 Warm-up

1. 20, 10, 100, 99

2 My Year in Math

1. Accept all reflections – read them together

3 Final Self-Check

1. Discuss growth since fall; compare to early worksheets if saved

4 Grand Finale

1. 44 (even, $40-50$, $4+4=8$); $4 \times 5 = 20$ balloons

5 Certificate

1. Sign it, date it, make it a ceremony! Congratulations to you too, teacher.
