

Monday: Number Bonds**1 Warm-up: Make 10**

1. $7+3$, $4+6$, $9+1$, $2+8$

2 Number Bonds of 10

1. 6 and 4, 3 and 7, 8 and 2, 5 and 5

3 Number Bonds to 20

1. 14: 9 and 5; 13: 8 and 5; 15: 7 and 8; 12: 6 and 6

4 Number Talk

1. $9+7$ is bigger (adding more to the same 9)
2. $9+5$ is bigger (bigger first addend, same 5)

5 Challenge Two Ways

1. $8+7=15$, $9+6=15$ – accept any two valid strategies (make 10, near doubles, counting on)

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Tuesday: Making 10 Strategy**1 Warm-up: 10 Plus**

1. 13, 16, 18, 15

2 Make a 10

1. $9+4$: $9+1=10$, $10+3=13$ | $8+6$: $8+2=10$, $10+4=14$ | $9+7$: $9+1=10$, $10+6=16$ | $8+5$: $8+2=10$, $10+3=13$

3 Estimate First

1. $7+6$: more (13), $4+3$: less (7), $8+9$: more (17), $5+4$: less (9)

4 Missing Numbers

1. $9+6=15$, $6+7=13$, $8+9=17$, $8+6=14$

5 Step-by-Step Make-10

1. $7+8$: $7+3=10$, $10+5=15$, answer 15 | $9+6$: $9+1=10$, $10+5=15$, answer 15

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Wednesday: Doubles & Near Doubles**1 Warm-up: Doubles**

1. 12, 14, 16, 18

2 Near Doubles

1. $6+7=13$ ($12+1$), $7+8=15$ ($14+1$), $8+9=17$ ($16+1$), $5+6=11$ ($10+1$)

3 Word Problems

1. 15 shells ($8+7$), 14 birds ($9+5$)

4 Find the Error

1. $9+6=14$ is WRONG – should be 15 ($9+1=10$, $10+5=15$)
2. $7+7=14$ is CORRECT

5 Create Own

1. Accept any fact with sum 11-20 solved two valid ways

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Thursday: Word Problems with Facts to 20

1 Warm-up

1. 17, 11, 11, 16

2 Word Problems

1. 16 cars ($7+9$)
2. 7 beads ($8+7=15$, so $15-8=7$)
3. 8 frogs ($6+8=14$, so $14-6=8$)

3 Two-Step

1. Step 1: $8+6=14$, Step 2: $14-5=9$ apples

4 Number Talk

1. Same – $8+7=7+8$ (order doesn't change the sum; both 15)
2. Same – move 1 from 5 to 9: $9+5=10+4$ (both 14)

5 Create Own

1. Accept student-created addition problems with sum ≤ 20

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Friday: Review & Self-Check

1 Warm-up

1. 13, 16, 13, 17

2 Estimate First

1. $9+7$: more (16), $6+6$: less (12), $8+9$: more (17), $7+5$: less (12)

3 Fluency Review

1. 15, 12, 14, 14, 14, 18

4 Word Problems

1. 17 books ($9+8$)
2. 8 points ($6+8=14$, so $14-6=8$)

5 Number Bonds Review

1. 16: 9 and 7; 14: 8 and 6; 13: 7 and 6

6 Self-Check

1. Accept student self-assessment and reflection
