

1 Warm-up: 10 Plus a Number

2-min Fluency Warm-up — 10 plus a number is easy!

$10 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$

$10 + 6 = \underline{\quad}$

$10 + 8 = \underline{\quad}$

2 Make a 10 to Add

Make a 10 first! Break apart the second number: give some to make 10, then add the rest.

$9 + 4 = \underline{\quad}$

3 Estimate First!

Estimate First! BEFORE solving, circle: is the sum MORE or LESS than 10? Then solve.

$7 + 6$

more than 10 / less than 10

4 Find the Missing Number

Find the missing number. Think: what goes with this part to make the whole?

$\underline{\quad} + 6 = 15$

$\underline{\quad} + 7 = 13$

$\underline{\quad} + 9 = 17$

$\underline{\quad} + 6 = 14$

5 Step-by-Step Make-10

Write each step of the make-10 strategy.

$7 + 8$

$7 + 3 = \underline{\quad}$
