

1 Add 10

When you add 10, only the **tens digit** changes. The ones stay the same.

$23 + 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$45 + 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$67 + 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$12 + 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

2 Add Multiples of 10

Add the tens. Keep the ones.

$34 + 20 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$56 + 30 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

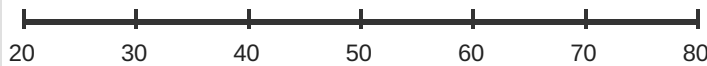
$78 + 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$42 + 50 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

3 Number Line Jumps

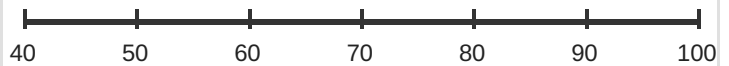
Use the number line. Mark jumps of 10 from the first number.

$25 + 30 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



Mark jumps of 10 starting at 25

$47 + 40 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



Mark jumps of 10 starting at 47

4 Number Talk: Which is Bigger?

Number Talk — Which sum is bigger? Explain **WITHOUT** calculating.

$34 + 20 \text{ or } 34 + 30$

5 Challenge: Three Numbers
