

1 Subtract 10

When you subtract 10, only the **tens digit** changes. The ones stay the same.

$53 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$75 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$87 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$42 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

2 Subtract Multiples of 10

Subtract the tens. Keep the ones.

$54 - 20 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$86 - 30 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

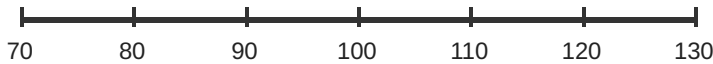
$88 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$83 - 20 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

3 Number Line Jumps

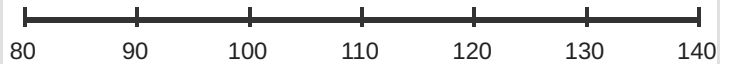
Use the number line. Mark jumps of 10 backward from the first number.

$75 - 30 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



Mark jumps of 10 backward from 75

$87 - 40 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



Mark jumps of 10 backward from 87

4 Number Talk: Which Difference is Bigger?

Number Talk — Which difference is bigger? Explain WITHOUT calculating.

75 - 20 or 75 - 40

5 Challenge: Three Numbers

Challenge — Subtract all the tens first, then all the ones.

$95 - 30 - 20 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$83 - 50 - 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
