

1 Visual Regrouping: 10 Ones = 1 Ten

When the ones add up to 10 or more, we **regroup**: trade 10 ones for 1 ten.

Look at the ones. When they make 10 or more, circle them and trade for a ten.

28 + 35

Regroup 10 ones as 1 ten

47 + 26

Regroup 10 ones as 1 ten

2 Simple Regrouping

Add the ones. If you get 10 or more, regroup. Then add the tens.
